If you are in need of extra time to pay the fee, please return the form and indicate that you will be paying the fee in the coming weeks. We have numerous families that are waiting to be informed concerning enrollment. Please remember the \$200 fee will be deducted from your August tuition. We have also been informed that the Diocese will be distributing and receiving all the financial aid forms this year for scholarship and assistance. This will be a new format for all parents. The Diocese will be working with the FACTS Company to oversee all elements of the paperwork and required information. This is to mainstream the procedures and remove school personnel from confidential information. As soon as we receive the required paperwork, it will be distributed to all families.
