
## Family Connection Newsletter November 17 – November 21





## Tomorrow, Friday, November 14<sup>th</sup> will be a full day of school with aftercare at the normal hours.

- 1. The Parent Association meeting is tonight, <u>Thursday</u>, <u>November 13<sup>th</sup> from 6-7 PM</u>. The meeting will cover our Christmas activities!
- 2. Preschool 8<sup>th</sup> grade will be attending the Cincinnati Cyclones Hockey Game on Tuesday, November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at Heritage Bank Arena in downtown Cincinnati. I am sending home a permission slip form that must be turned in by Monday, November 17<sup>th</sup> in order for your child to attend the game. The game will be played during school hours and we will have normal school start time and normal dismissal. The tickets have already been paid for and we will ride the CovCath bus to and from the game. A bagged lunch will be prepared by the cafeteria for every child who would like one. If your student is packing their own lunch, it must be packed in a disposable bag, such as a brown paper bag, NOT A LUNCH BOX.
