Our last day of school before the Thanksgiving Break will be Tuesday, November 25th. We will dismiss on this day at 12 PM with no aftercare.

1. There will be a Virtus training here at Prince of Peace in the gym Monday, November 24, 2025, from 6-8:30 PM. for our families (and anyone else you know who wishes to be trained across the diocese). The cost is \$50 for a background check; if you need financial assistance to cover the cost, please contact Dr. Noll or Mrs. Middendorf. We do not want the cost to be a hinderance in getting your certification.
2. The Holy Cross High School Cheerleaders and their coaches are sponsoring a Parent's Night Out on Saturday, December 6, 2025, from 6-9 PM in the Holy Cross Gym. The gym is located on 36th and Church Street in Latonia, KY (the gym is right next to the church). The cost is \$25 for one child or \$50 for two or more children. The evening will include a showing of the Polar Express movie, crafts, snacks, and games.
3. Please note the following events and off days in Nov/Dec:
 - a. We will officially be closed Wednesday, November 26-28, 2025, for the Thanksgiving holiday and return to school Monday, December 1st.
