1. The NKY Health Department Healthy Smiles program will be held here at school on May 19th (we needed to change the date). If you have already signed up electronically or by paper, you do not need to fill out another form. The department's service is free and provides the following: dental assessment, dental cleaning, fluoride treatment, sealants for teeth if needed, a KY dental form for kindergarten entrance if needed, and referral to local dentist if further treatment is needed. I encourage all PreK-K parents to take advantage of this FREE opportunity.
