Since we had to move Field Day to May 15th, tomorrow May 1st, students can wear jeans and an appropriate shirt/sweatshirt to school tomorrow. 3. MAP testing is ongoing. It needs to be completed by May 8th. It is essential that students be at school on time for testing next week so we can have it completed by then.
4. Don't forget about volleyball signups for next school year for grades 3-8 (both girls and boys). There are flyers in the main office if you need one. Let Mrs. Middendorf know and she will send one home with your student.
