Here are some reminders for you as we head into the first full week of school:

1. Don't forget to turn in your registration paperwork as well as your RED FOLDER. The folder will come home every Thursday and we would like to have all folders returned by Monday. If you are a new student this year, we ask that you make sure you turn in the following items to Mrs. Middendorf: birth certificate, copy of Social Security card, updated immunization on a Kentucky immunization form, and a baptismal certificate (if applicable).
2. Tomorrow will be our first school mass for grades 1-8. PreK-K will join us next week. Unless otherwise noted, all masses are on Friday at 9am.
3. Thursday, August 27th, will be our first Spirit Day. Students can wear any shirt that says "Prince of Peace" on it to school with their uniform shorts/pants. Girls can wear Spirit Wear underneath their jumpers or with uniform shorts/pants. We gave some POP athletics shirts to younger students and we will give those away to anyone who fits in one. I will be turning in the first set of Spirit Wear orders on Friday afternoon (we may get these back by Thursday).
